Who is Otto Kahn?

As many of you may know, Otto Hermann Kahn was the original owner of CAA headquarters. He was a Jewish immigrant from Germany. He was born in Mannheim Germany, the fifth child, third son, out of eight children. From a very young age, his father had already decided that Otto was going to be a banker. Otto, being a good son, started working at the Karlsruhe bank as a junior clerk. He then continued this until he was 20. Showing such amazing talents at the Deutsche Bank he became second in command there! In 1896, he married Adelaid Wolff, and

they were married until the day he died. He had three children, all of whom were as successful as their father. He had two daughters (Maud and Margaret) and two sons (Gilbert and Roger). He then decided to build the Otto Kahn Mansion. It took Kahn from 1914 to 1918 to construct the building. He resided in it for 16 years. (1918-1934). He suffered from high blood pressure and died on March 29, 1934 from a heart attack. He was then buried in St. John's Memorial Cemetery. In 1934, the building became the Convent of the Sacred Heart, the school that we know and love today.
