## CAA 2019 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ★ Creative Arts & Athletics (CAA) Kids Club will be housed in two locations this summer - in the mornings we will be at our new athletic facility located at 406 East 91<sup>st</sup> Street and in the afternoons we will be at 1 East 91st St.
- ★ Camp begins on **Monday, July 1<sup>st</sup>**. The Program's Coordinator is a teacher. The Interns are also teachers. Both are Sacred Heart teachers during the year. They will be assisted by CITs & Interns.
- ★ **Drop off is at 406 East 91st Street at 8:30am daily but no later than 8:45am.**
- ★ Campers will have swimming either 1st or 2nd period (9:10am or 10:10am) so we suggest your child wears his/her suit to camp. Please bring a towel, **bathing cap** and a plastic zip-lock bag every day.
- ★ Wear play clothes that you can move around in: T-shirts, sweats, shorts. The only acceptable footwear is **sneakers**. NO Flip-flops or crocs. Please **label** all clothing, lunch bags and back-packs.
- ★ A daily snack consisting of juice and crackers, or something similar, will be provided.
- ★ We are a **NUT-FREE** camp. Please cooperate by not bringing any nut products to camp.
- ★ Bring your own lunch. There is no refrigeration so you may want to include a cool pack. **Don't forget to pack a drink.**
- ★ The New York Transit Authority requires all children above the age of six to pay when traveling on city buses or subways. We are providing free **METROCARDS** for the month of July for all campers.
- ★ Each day after lunch the Kids Club campers will be bused to 1 East 91st street and join the Choice Program for the noontime show and their afternoon classes of art and drama. **Dismissal is at 3pm Monday – Thursday from 1 East 91st St.**
- ★ **Dismissal on Fridays is at 1pm from 1 East 91<sup>st</sup> Street.**
- ★ The Kids Club will also join CAA Choice Program for a Field Trip to the Broadway matinee performance of *The Gazillion Bubble Show* on Thursday, July 1<sup>st</sup>. Curtain is at 2pm. We will travel to the theatre on chartered buses. All campers will be picked up directly at the theatre. More detailed information to follow.
